#### Marshalltown

### **Old Business**

Tournament Rule changes for 2017

- Tournament Rule 2.0 First and second round tournament games for all peewees will be officiated by one certified umpire behind the plate. Semifinal and championship peewee games will be officiated by 2 certified umpires. Pee Wee Girls Semifinals will have one umpire. All tournament games for Minors, Majors, and Babe Ruth will be officiated by 2 certified umpires. The Board will assign schedule umpires for each tournament game. Host towns will be responsible for paying each umpire \$25 per game. The Board requests that towns please provide umpires complimentary concessions. Towns hosting ALL tournament games will be reimbursed for umpire fees at the Fall Rules Meeting. (Will reword this at Tournament meeting.) The Board will directly pay the umpires at the championship games. If the umpire does not show up within the stated time, the host town will find a replacement person (minimum 18 years old) to umpire behind the plate or bases. If either town refuses to play, they will forfeit the game. Towns MUST have full umpire gear available.
- **Tournament Rule 13.0** All championship games will be played without the 10-run rule. No time limit for championship games. The Board will keep an official book. Both teams need to report any changes to official book keeper.
- **Tournament Rule 14.0** All team rosters must be submitted prior to the tournament scheduling meeting. Only players appearing on the official team roster are eligible to play in tournament games. A player may play on only one team in a specific age division. If not enough players, refer to Rule of 1.03 of Boys and Girls Rules.

Add Player #'s on their Rosters ... will need to include for Tournament time. Will have more discussion on this at Tournament Meeting.

If each town could have Rule book in the concession stand so coaches don't need to bring these around.

**Boys Rule Changes Discussion** 

- 8.01 Pitchers are allowed to pitch one county regulation game (PeeWee 4 Innings, Minors 5 Innings.) If pitched more than allotted innings, team forfeits.
- 7.06 **PeeWee Only** The runner shall not leave his base before the ball reaches the batter crosses home plate, or he shall be declared out.

### Girls Rule Changes Discussion

- 7.06 **PeeWee Only** There will be no stealing in PeeWees. The runner shall not leave her base before the ball crosses home plate, or she shall be declared out.
- New Rule 15.13 Regulation softballs will not be used in T-ball games. The ball to be used in all games will be a soft touch core ball, such as the Diamond Flexi Ball.
- New Boys **Rule 11.07** and **Girls Rule 10.07**: No town in the league shall have more than 2 teams per division. If town feels they have an exception, town shall bring circumstances to the board for discussion and review. All final decisions to be done before the day of scheduling meeting.
- Rule 6.01 Every batter MUST wear approved protective helmets with facemask and chinstrap at ALL TIMES while running, batting, waiting on deck, or catching. THE CATCHER MUST WEAR A HELMET AND THROAT GUARD, EVEN WHEN WARMING UP THE PITCHER. If a batter hits the ball and throws her helmet off before the play is stopped, or the ball is dead, SHE SHALL BE DECLARED OUT. However, if her helmet falls off while she is running, there is no penalty.
