Old Business

Tournament Rule changes for 2018

> Tournament Rule 2.0 First and second round tournament games for all peewees will be officiated by one certified u mpire behind the plate. Semifinal and championship peewee games will be officiated by 2 certified umpires. Pee Wee Girls Semifinals will have one umpire. All tournament games for Minors, Majors, and Babe Ruth will be officiated by 2 certifiedumpires. The Board will assign schedule umpires for each tournament game. Host towns will be responsible for paying each umpire \$30per game. The Board requests that towns please provide umpires complimentary concessions. Towns hosting ALL tournament games will be reimbursed for umpire fees at the Fall Rules Meeting for all games after the first round.

The Board will directly pay the umpires at the championship games. If the umpire does not show up within the stat ed time, the host town or the two teams playing

will find a replacement person (minimum 18 years old) to umpire behind the plate or bases. If either town refuses t o play, they will forfeit the game. Towns MUST have full umpire gear available.

13.0 All championship games will be played without the 10-run rule. No time limit for championship games. The Board will keep an official book. Both teams need to report any chances to official book keeper.

13.1 No coach pitch for all tournament games.

13.2 All games in the tournament will bat 9 players and only have 9 players in the field. You can play with 8 players but then you must take an out for the ninth batter.

Girls Rule Changes

Discussion on no stealing in PWs. Board decided we need to have two years before a rule change. Discussion will be had next year.

2.05 PeeWee games will consist of the following pitching format:

If a pitcher pitches three balls to any batter in the inning, an adult pitcher from the offensive team will enter the game and pitch to that batter from within the pitching circle and that batter

will have to hit or strike out. If the batter has 2 strikes, the pitcher has the opportunity to strike out the batter until 4 balls are thrown. Then the adult pitcher enters the game. No bunts or walks are permitted off the adult pitcher. The youth pitcher will return to pitch to the subsequent batter. The youth pitcher performs all fielding responsibilities, even when the adult is pitching. The youth pitcher must stand somewhere behind the pitching rubber within the circle when the adult pitcher is pitching.

In the last 2 weeks of the season, if coaches agree, pitchers can pitch the entire inning or game and there will be no coach pitch.
