- Girls/Boys Rule Changes Discussion
  - o PW Boys 3<sup>rd</sup> base runner can steal to home once there is a play made on a runner. If pitcher is not on the pitching rubber and he makes a play.
  - PW Girls ... every infielder should have a mask on. As of now Girls Rule: 9.07 All pitchers within the Peewee division must wear a face mask. Keep this rule and leave up to towns to create the rule.
  - Minimum age limit on our teams. Boys/Girls Rule:
    - 1.02 Age Divisions
      - 1.02.1 T-Ball Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> graders. Prefer no Four (4) Year Olds.
      - 1.02.2 PeeWee 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> graders.
      - 1.02.3 Minors 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, and 7<sup>th</sup> graders.
      - 1.02.4 Babe Ruth 8<sup>th</sup> 11<sup>th</sup> graders.
    - o There needs to be a reminder sent to all towns before registration. Rule motioned by Bryce to Prefer no Four (4) Year Olds. Tracy seconded. All were in favor.
  - Discussion on number of players on each team and sending kids to other towns.
  - o Tracy read through rules and discussion about sportsmanship.
    - o 14.02/15.02 Coaches are to set the example. There will be no smoking, chewing tobacco, alcohol, or profanity on the field, or in the dugout, by either coaches or players. Penalty for infraction of this rule shall begin with a verbal warning of the offending coach/player by the umpire. Subsequent infraction penalties can range from verbal warning to ejection from the game of the next offending coach/player. The umpire shall impose such penalty according to the severity of the infraction.
